Health and Safety

Camp Timberledge is licensed by the State of Pennsylvania. Our screened adult staff provide constant camper supervision. Floatation devices are worn by all campers in watercraft. Balanced meals and daily rest periods are ensured. On-site medical personnel (EMT/Nurse) are on staff, and a doctor is always on-call.

Our Leadership Training At Camp Timberledge (LT@CT) program is designed to help teens develop the skills needed to be effective leaders. The LT@CT program is open to youth entering 10th grade through 12th grade, and applications must be approved by the Director. 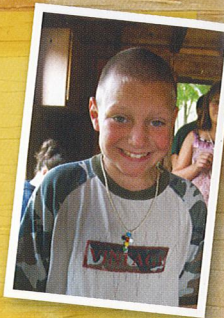

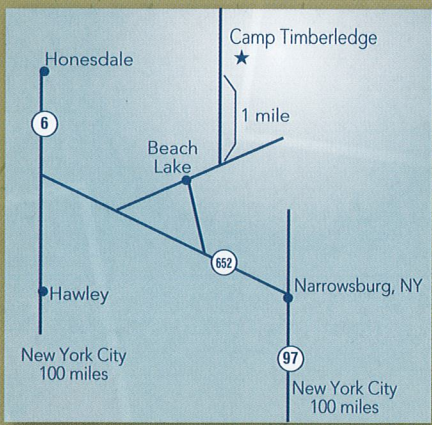

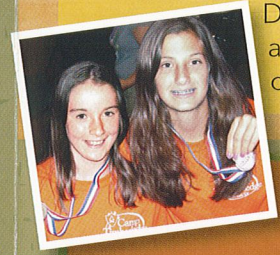
